












# STEM at SJE

St. John the Evangelist School has begun preparations to apply for **STEM Certification** through **Cognia**, an organization that provides accreditation and certification for educational institutions. This certification process will allow us to reflect on how our STEM program has evolved and to celebrate the progress we've made in creating a strong culture of STEM learning.

**STEM**, which stands for science, technology, engineering, and mathematics, is at the heart of our mission to prepare students for a rapidly changing world. Over the years, our program has grown from shared iPad carts to a one-to-one device model, where every student now has access to a Chromebook or iPad. These tools empower students to research, create, and collaborate effectively.

Our **science curriculum** emphasizes hands-on investigations and real-world applications. Students are encouraged to demonstrate their understanding through meaningful, authentic connections to the world around them. One example of this is our partnership with **Fulton County 4-H Clubs**, through which we are transforming our school garden into a thriving **learning garden**, connecting science concepts to agriculture, ecology, and sustainability.

The **Engineering Design Process** is another key component of our STEM program and is integrated across all subject areas. Students engage in creative problem-solving challenges—such as designing tools to help keep track of pencils, building boats to help storybook characters escape an island, or creating 3D-printed models of snowflakes. These activities foster innovation, critical thinking, and collaboration.

Through this certification journey, St. John the Evangelist reaffirms its commitment to continuous improvement and excellence in STEM education. We are proud of how far we've come and look forward to the next steps in our growth as a STEM-certified school.

# Remembering Chase


