GRACE Scholarship Process School Year 2024-2025

GRACE Scholars is a Georgia Student Scholarship Organization (SSO) serving Catholic school students in the Archdiocese of Atlanta and the Diocese of Savannah through (30) participating Catholic schools. *All GRACE awards are made on the basis of financial need.* Please follow the steps below to guide you through the scholarship process:

- **1. Submit an application** for enrollment to the school of your choice. Complete any steps necessary for acceptance. *Inquire about available Financial Aid including GRACE Scholarships*.
- 2. Complete the online application to FACTS Grant and Aid or the designated outside financial aid company by March 1. (The school has information on financial aid companies). FACTS or other financial aid companies use the application information to calculate the student's/family's financial need. Financial need is based on several variables including family income, number of children, and tuition rate. Tax documents will be required. There is no maximum family income. FACTS or other designated financial aid company reports the calculated financial need to the school and then the school determines scholarship awards based on need and funding available for scholarships.
- 3. Complete the GRACE Scholars Scholarship Application and submit the application to the school. Additional documentation will be required as noted under the "Certification" section of the application. All additional documentation must be attached to the application. March 1 is the deadline for awards announced during the spring enrollment period. Applications submitted after the March 1 deadline will be reviewed in the order received upon completion and may be subject to the availability of funds at that time.
- **4.** Each school reviews applications and makes recommendations to GRACE. The GRACE staff reviews applications for compliance and availability of funds and the GRACE executive committee determines final award decisions. The annual award will not exceed the lesser of calculated financial need, 80% of tuition, or the state index calculated by the Georgia Department of Education. Awards cover the student's career at the school as long as demonstrated financial need eligibility is maintained.
- **5.** GRACE Scholars generates an award letter addressed to the parent/guardian and sends it to the school principal/president. Included with the letter is an acceptance letter. The schools provide award letters to parents/guardians, collect signed acceptance letters, and return them to GRACE. Once notified of an award, the family must accept or decline the award to finalize the scholarship process. If a response is not given to the school within the stated deadline, the award is subject to being given to another family in need. *It is the responsibility of the family to maintain contact with the school during this process.* The school is responsible for non-award notifications.
- 6. The school receives payment from GRACE that will be applied to the student's tuition agreement. No award payment is issued to the school until a signed acceptance letter is on file with GRACE.
